

ORDINANCE NO. 24

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CAMROSA WATER DISTRICT  
REPEALING ORDINANCE NO.23, AND ESTABLISHING  
A POLICY FOR ALL APPLICATIONS FOR NEW WATER  
SERVICE CONNECTIONS**

The Board of Directors of the Camrosa Water District do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 23 is hereby repealed and superseded by the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. DATE WHEN FEES LEVIED. Fees for the funding of the aforesaid application for new water service connections shall be levied:


- A. Upon application for issuance of a Water Will Serve Letter; application for the Will Serve letter will constitute an Application for Utility Service, and installation of a water meter, pursuant to Camrosa Water District Rules and Regulations.
- B. Upon a partial or total change from agricultural use to domestic use. If incremental partial changes from agricultural use to domestic occur, a one-time fee shall be levied only upon the initial change. No fee shall be levied if any of the events set forth in A or B occurred prior to June 27, 1979.
- C. No connection, surcharge or groundwater fee as hereinafter set forth shall be levied upon application for water service to a dwelling unit or other structure presently utilizing water service from a supply other than Camrosa, if the dwelling unit or other structure was in existence on June 26, 1979, and the purpose for which the dwelling unit or other structure was utilized on said date is the same as of the date of application for water service, and if the application and new water service connection is completed prior to December 31, 1990, if a provision for connection is adjacent to the property.
- D. Any application for new water service connection received after December 31, 1990 will be subject to all fees for new water service connections which are in effect at the time of application for service, if a waterline or any other provision for connection exists adjacent to the property.
- E. Where there is no provision for service connection adjacent to the property, the condition for payment of fees in effect will be 2 years from the date facilities are made available adjacent to the property.

SECTION 3. FEE SCHEDULE


- A. The policy and provisions herein shall apply to all fees for the purpose of providing adequate facilities and acceptable supply and quality for water service. The fees set forth and application thereof shall be in compliance with all applicable laws.
- B. All fees pertaining to new water service connections shall be adopted by Resolution from time to time, by the Board of Directors, and administered by the Manager. Notice will be provided to the public within a reasonable time after such fees are adjusted or a policy is amended.

SECTION 4. PUBLIC NOTICE. This Ordinance shall be published once in the Camarillo Daily News within ten (10) days after adoption and shall be posted for thirty (30) days after adoption at the District office.
